



## **“Blessed to Be a Blessing” – Luke 1:5-55**

**Fun Question:** What is your favorite Christmas movie of all time? Why?

1. Moving from brokenness to blessedness is not about changing your circumstances but trusting God with an active faith. In what ways were you struck by the stories of Zechariah and Mary and their faith (or lack of faith) in Luke’s opening chapter?
2. Perhaps when Jesus considered who in his life was most richly blessed by God, his own earthly mother came to mind. Who comes to your mind when you think of someone that is “blessed” beyond measure? Why?
3. In what ways have you seen this truth (faith moving you from feeling broken to blessed) become a reality in your own life? Or in what ways do you wish to see it become more of a reality right now?
4. In what ways have you seen God use your brokenness to not only bless you but bless those around you? How has this impacted your view of your own brokenness and how God goes about advancing the kingdom of heaven on earth?

### **Deeper Study**

Observe, study, and analyze Luke 1:5-55. What do you make of the differences and similarities between Mary’s song and Jesus’ Beatitudes?
